

Pre-Kindergarten DRESS CODE 2023-2024

DRESS CODE

Pre-Kindergarten GIRLS

(FLYNN O'HARA – indicates items must be purchased through Flynn O'Hara)

- A. FLYNN O'HARA: School sweater navy blue v-neck pullover with school logo.
- B. Plain polo shirts, without any logo, long or short sleeve in solid pastel colors of only: light blue, white, cream, pink, or yellow. However, white polo shirts with the school logo purchased from FLYNN O'HARA is an option. No denim shirts permitted. If the student chooses to wear button down Oxford dress shirts, they must be fully buttoned except for the top button.
- C. FLYNN O'HARA: Solid color skirt with an elastic waist band and not button type in navy blue, khaki, or gray. Skorts are permitted as long as the shorts are not visible. No denim permitted. Skirt/skort should be no higher than 5" above the bend in the knee. If the skirt or skort from Flynn O'Hara does not fit, parents may purchase something comparable. This clothing must meet the approval of the Pre-Kindergarten staff.
- D. FLYNN O'HARA: Solid color full length dress pants in navy blue, khaki, or gray. These pants are not to be rolled up and must be hemmed properly. If the pants from Flynn O'Hara do not fit your child, parents may purchase something comparable; however, they must meet the approval of the Pre-Kindergarten staff.
- E. Belts are not required for Pre-Kindergarten but may be worn. Elastic waistband pants or skirt/skorts are recommended.
- F. Pre-Kindergarteners should wear sneakers each day, however, serviceable, safe and plain rubber soled shoes may be worn on certain occasions designated by the Pre-Kindergarten staff. Ballet slippers, light-up or ornamental sneakers, sneakers that make sounds, and flip flops are not permitted during the school day or during "dress down days".
- G. Knee Socks/Tights are required at all times. Must be solid color, not printed, in the colors of the dress code shirts, pants, or skirts. Knee socks must be worn over the calf, but not over the knee. Ankle socks are permitted. Jeggings/Leggings are not permitted. "No show" socks are not permitted.
- H. "Boot Days" during inclement weather. Administration will deem "Boot Days" by posting the info on our website. Students may wear boots all day

I. Flynn O'Hara – school navy fleece – worn over school sweater during colder months as designated.

The only differences in the dress code for warm months will be the option of not wearing the school sweater. These periods will be designated by the Head of School.

During cold months the Pre-Kindergarten will be required to wear a special Oak Hill Academy sweat suit for special activities. These days will be designated by the Pre-Kindergarten staff by email or a printed notice. The sweat suits will be purchased through the Pre-Kindergarten office at the beginning of the school year.

Pre-Kindergarten BOYS

(FLYNN O'HARA – indicates items must be purchased through Flynn O'Hara)

- A. FLYNN O'HARA: School sweater navy blue v-neck pullover with school logo.
- B. Plain polo shirts, without any logo, long or short sleeve in solid pastel colors of only: light blue, white, cream, pink, or yellow. However, white polo shirts with the school logo purchased from FLYNN O'HARA is an option. No denim shirts permitted. - C. Dress ties are not required for Pre-Kindergarten but may be worn.
- D. FLYNN O'HARA: Solid color dress pants in navy blue, khaki, or gray. No denim permitted. Pants are to be hemmed properly and not rolled up. If the pants from Flynn O'Hara do not fit, parents may purchase something comparable. This clothing must meet the approval of the Pre-Kindergarten staff.
- E. Belts are not required in Pre-Kindergarten but may be worn if the student chooses. Elastic waistband pants are recommended.
- J. Pre-Kindergarteners should wear sneakers each day, however, serviceable, safe and plain rubber soled shoes may be worn on certain occasions designated by the Pre-Kindergarten staff. Ballet slippers, light-up or ornamental sneakers, sneakers that make sounds, and flip flops are not permitted during the school day or during "dress down days".
- F. Socks are required at all times. Solid colors, not printed, in the same dress code colors of the pants and shirts. Must be worn over the ankle (crew sock). "No show" socks are not permitted.
- H. "Boot Days" during inclement weather. Administration will deem "Boot Days" by posting the info on our website. Students may wear boots all day. If boots are not worn, uniform shoes must be worn.
- Flynn O'Hara school navy fleece worn over school sweater during colder months as designated.
