

DRAMA CLUB DESCRIPTIONS 2023 - 2024

Upper School Dance Ensemble Grades 5th to 8th (Mondays)

The Dance Ensemble is open to students in grades 5th-8th. The Ensemble will meet on Mondays in the SAC and/or Drama Room from 2:30-3:10. Rehearsal schedule is subject to change. Updates will be sent to parents and students via email and posted in the Dance Ensemble Google Classroom.

The purpose of this performance group is to prepare original dance pieces that may be performed at the Veterans Day Assembly and/or the Winter Arts Festival. All genres of dance are welcomed! Tap, ballet, lyrical, hip-hop, Irish, Indian, modern, and more!

If you would like to be a part of the Upper School Dance Ensemble the following is required:

*You must be an accomplished dancer who has been taking lessons for 2 or more years and are **CURRENTLY** taking lessons privately or within a studio.

*Mandatory weekly attendance is **required**! Full commitment is a MUST!!!! Please note that as a performance nears, there will be additional practices and dress rehearsals.

*Dancers will also be required to purchase costumes, dance attire, shoes, etc...if needed for performances at these assemblies.

<u>Thespian Troupe Grades 6th - 8th (Thursdays and Fridays; See Schedule in</u> Thespian Google Classroom)

Oak Hill Academy's Jr. Thespian Troupe #89635 is open to students in grades 6th - 8th. The Thespians work towards a short performance for the Winter Arts Festival assembly. Additionally, students have the option of being inducted into the International Thespian Society at the Junior level. This is an HONOR SOCIETY!
