5th & 6th Grade – Sept. 15, Sept. 29, Oct. 13, Oct. 27, Nov. 10, Dec. 1 (contest), Dec. 15 (contest), Jan. 5, Jan. 12 (contest), Feb. 2, Feb. 9 (contest), Mar. 1, and Mar. 8 (contest).
