

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND GENERAL INFORMATION FOR 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

## I. Open House and School Visits

a. Oak Hill Academy holds regularly scheduled open houses throughout the school year. These provide a good opportunity for prospective parents to speak at length with teachers and students. The following are dates for open houses during 2023 and 2024:

Saturday, October 28, 2023 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Friday, February 23, 2024 9:00 a.m.

Friday, December 8, 2023 9:00 a.m. Saturday, April 13, 2024 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

Saturday, January 6, 2024 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Friday, May 3, 2024 9:00 a.m.

b. Individual tours of the campus with the Director of Admissions are welcome and available by appointment. These tours can be scheduled by contacting the admissions office at <a href="mailto:admissions@oakhillacademy.com">admissions@oakhillacademy.com</a> or (732) 530-1343 ext. 1.

- II. Parents are asked to follow this procedure when making application to Oak Hill Academy:
  - a. Visits to the school (personal tour, open house, virtual tour) are encouraged prior to application.
  - b. Oak Hill Academy utilizes an online system for its admissions process. In order to complete an application, prospective families need to create an account through <a href="OHA's Blackbaud Management System">OHA's Blackbaud Management System</a>. Each application requires a one time non-refundable fee of \$80, payable through the portal.
  - c. Through the online system, applicants can upload a copy of the student's most recent report card and most recent standardized test scores (if applicable).
  - d. A teacher recommendation form can be sent directly from the admissions portal to one of your child's present teachers. We request this form be returned prior to the entrance test date.
  - e. After Oak Hill Academy has received this information, we will confirm an entrance test date. A developmental readiness evaluation will be individually administered to students entering grades PK and K.
  - f. Prospective students are asked to spend a day or part of a day (for grades PreK-1) in an Oak Hill classroom.
  - g. After the entrance test has been reviewed and all materials have been received, families will be personally contacted in order to hold final discussions and go over test results.
  - h. Finally, a decision will be made regarding acceptance, and enrollment materials will be sent electronically if applicable.

## III. Policy

- Applications are considered based on date of application, with preference given to current Oak Hill families.
- Tuition Assistance is available to qualified applicants on a limited basis until current deadlines are passed and/or all budgeted funds have been allocated.
- Merit Scholarships are available on a limited basis for students entering grades 5-8. If applying, there is a separate process. All materials must be submitted at the same time as other admissions requirements.

## IV. Transportation

State law in New Jersey requires school districts that transport public school students to also provide busing for private school students, within a 20-mile radius. Where it is not feasible for a local Board of Education to arrange for transportation, parents are given a reimbursement of approximately \$1000 by the Board. Your local Board of Education can tell you whether they provide busing to Oak Hill Academy and the times and route applicable for you.
