- Builds confidence
- Develops real-world problem solving
- Prepares students for high-level future learning

Supported by **Dr. Costa's Levels of Questioning**, students learn to move beyond recall into analysis, evaluation, and creation.

Learning at OHA is driven by wonder. Students are encouraged to:

- Explore ideas that excite them
- Ask “why?” and “what if?”
- Engage in hands-on discovery
